The deadline to register to vote through the GeauxVote Online Registration System is March 8.

- The deadline to request an absentee ballot is March 25 by 4:30 p.m. (other than military and overseas voters). Voters can request an absentee ballot online at www.geauxvote.com or in writing through the Registrar of Voters Office.
- The deadline for a voter to return a voted absentee ballot to their parish's Registrar of Voters Office is March 28 by 4:30 p.m. (other than military and overseas voters).
- Due to unpredictable mail delivery speeds, absentee voters utilizing the United States Postal Service are encouraged to allow additional time for their ballot to reach its destination.
- Polls open at 7 a.m. and close at 8 p.m. on Election Day. Anyone in line at 8 p.m. will be allowed to vote..
- Voters are encouraged to sign up for electronic notifications via
 GeauxVote Mobile.
- Voters should bring an ID with them to vote (Louisiana driver's license, Louisiana Special ID card, a generally recognized picture identification card with name and signature such as a passport, or a digital license via LA Wallet).
- Election results can be viewed in real-time via GeauxVote Mobile or at www.sos.la.gov. (M1 Runs 3_6_2025 Cost per run is \$192)
