Our Levels of Training

EMT & Paramedic

The primary focus of the EMT and the Paramedic is to provide basic emergency medical care and transportation for the critical and emergent patients who access the emergency medical system.

This individual possesses the basic knowledge and skills to provide patient care and transportation.

EMTs and Paramedics function as part of a comprehensive EMS response, under medical oversight. EMTs and Paramedics perform interventions with the basic equipment typically found on an ambulance. The EMT and Paramedic are a link from the scene to the emergency health care system.

- Gather medications, medical information, insurance cards and an ID
- Take CPR and First Aid Training before an emergency occurs.
