

- Public Notice -

Kinder Morgan Louisiana Pipeline LLC ("KMLP") is planning to construct and install its proposed Texas Access Project ("Project") in the states of Texas and Louisiana, as discussed in more detail below. KMLP, a Kinder Morgan, Inc. company, is an interstate natural gas transmission pipeline company that has been in operation since 2005. Its principal office is located at 1001 Louisiana Street, Houston, Texas 77002.

On March 6, 2026, KMLP filed an application seeking the issuance of a certificate of public convenience and necessity ("Application") with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission" or "FERC") for the Project. The Commission assigned Docket No. CP26-136-000 to the certificate proceeding.

The proposed Project includes the following facilities:

- Construction and installation of 3.05 miles of 48-inch outside diameter pipe from Jefferson County, Texas to Cameron Parish, Louisiana ("Mainline Extension");
- Construction and installation of two aboveground facilities with pigging assemblies at the beginning ("TAP Launcher Facility and Connection") and terminus ("TAP Receiver Facility and Tie-In") of the Mainline Extension;
- Installation of approximately 540 feet of 42-inch outside diameter pipe in Jefferson County, Texas for the connection of gas supply from an intrastate pipeline in Texas, the Trident Intrastate Pipeline ("TIP"), to the Mainline Extension ("TIP Connector");
- Installation of approximately

70 feet of 42-inch outside diameter pipe in Jefferson County, Texas for the connection of gas supply from the Texas Header, a new natural gas manifold system located in Jefferson County, Texas to be owned and operated by KMLP, to the Mainline Extension ("Header Connector");

- Installation of approximately 150 feet of 42-inch and 100 feet of 36-inch outside diameter pipe in Cameron Parish, Louisiana for the connection of gas supply from the Mainline Extension to KMLP's existing 42-inch Leg 1 pipeline ("Leg 1 Connector") and 36-inch Leg 2 pipeline ("Leg 2 Connector"), respectively;
- Modifications to KMLP's existing regulator and metering facilities at its existing Sabine Pass Metering Facility in Cameron Parish, Louisiana to ensure deliverability of new and diverse gas supply from the Project to existing facilities in Louisiana and make additional capacity available at KMLP's existing interconnection with Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America LLC; and
- Installation of a new interconnection with Louisiana LNG Gas Management LLC's ("Woodside") new liquefied natural gas terminal ("Woodside Terminal") on KMLP's existing 42-inch mainline in Calcasieu Parish, Louisiana ("Woodside Interconnect") and a skid-mounted electronic gas measurement building within the Woodside Terminal. The Woodside Interconnect facilities include a 42-inch x 30-inch tee, 30-inch block valve and approximately 25 feet of 30-inch pipe.

Please see the map included in this notice for the location of the proposed Project facilities.

KMLP is requesting that the Commission issue an order granting the requested authorizations no later than February 5, 2027. The issuance of the requested authorizations by that date will allow KMLP to complete and place a portion of the Project facilities in service by January 2028 to enable Woodside to begin the commissioning of its new facilities and to place the remainder of the Project in service by April 2028, to meet market demand and advance the delivery of critical natural gas supplies to the market.

During construction, restoration, and mitigation activities for the Project, KMLP will follow the Commission's Upland Erosion Control, Revegetation and Maintenance Plan (May 2013 version) and the Commission's Wetland and Waterbody Construction and Mitigation Procedures (May 2013 version), with approved deviations.



If you have not received such notice, your property is most likely not affected.
